

Dentist Checklist

Discuss IV sedation and other options for anxiety management and if patient wants IV, get in touch with us

Ensure medically that the patient is ASA grade 1 or 2 (if borderline 3, just get in touch). ASA is explained on my dentist video on my website

Ensure patient has watched the consent video on our website and has a copy of our consent form (also on website). Make sure they know to bring someone with them who can stay during the appointment

Ensure patient is aware of costs (£200 for the hour, £300 for 90 minutes, £400 for 2 hours) and has had a written estimate for the costs of the appointment

Book a minimum of one hours appointment in your diary

Book a sedation slot online at www.midlandsdentalsedation.co.uk at the same time you book the patient in your diary

Ensure you have a Full Emergency Oxygen cylinder available

Ensure a Dental assistant is present throughout procedure

During the appointment, Consent the patient again for treatment before the sedation starts, come in again once the patient is sedated and then you can leave after treatment is completed so that we can discharge the patient
